**EXPRESSING QUANTITY****Nouns (İsimler)**

Countable Nouns (Sayılabilen İsimler)		Uncountable Nouns (Sayılamayan İsimler)	
Singulars (Tekil)	Plurals (Çoğul)		
a book	→ books	milk	chocolate
an orange	→ oranges	butter	bread
a balloon	→ balloons	water	lemonade
a man	→ men	oil	salt
a person	→ people	cheese	sugar


- ✓ **A** or **an** comes before a singular countable noun. (**A** veya **an** sayılabilen tekil isimlerden önce gelir.)
 - a pen • an apple
 - a present • a university
- ✓ We make plural nouns by adding **-s**. (Çoğul isimleri **-s** ekleyerek yaparız.)
 - pens • apples
 - presents • universities
- ✓ Some nouns are irregular so they have irregular plural forms. (Bazı isimler düzensizdir, bu nedenle düzensiz çoğul formları vardır.)
 - a child → children
 - a person → people
- ✓ We don't use **a** or **an** for uncountable nouns. (Sayılamayan isimler için **a** veya **an** kullanmayız.)
 - ~~a~~ milk • ~~a~~ water
 - ~~a~~ lemonade • ~~a~~ butter

QUANTIFIERS (İ)**Some**



There are some apples.

some + plural noun




There is some milk.

some + uncountable noun


✓ We use **some** in positive sentences. (**Some** ifadesini olumlu cümlelerde kullanırız.)

Any



There aren't any apples.

any + plural nouns



Is there any milk?

any + uncountable noun

✓ We use **any** in negative sentences and questions. (**Any** ifadesini olumsuz cümlelerde ve sorularda kullanırız.)

*Note*

We use **some** in questions when we offer things. (Sorularda bir şeyler önerdiğimiz zaman **some** kullanırız.)

- Would you like some lemonade?
- Do you want some tea?

a few	 There are a few apples. a few + plural noun	a few: bir kaç	✓ We use a few in positive sentences with plurals. (A few ifadesini olumlu cümlelerde çoğul isimlerle kullanırız.)
a little	 There is a little milk. a little + uncountable noun	a little: biraz	✓ We use a little in positive sentences with uncountables. (A little ifadesini olumlu cümlelerde sayılamayan isimlerle kullanırız.)
a lot of	 There are a lot of apples. a lot of + plural noun  There is a lot of milk. a lot of + uncountable noun	a lot of: çok	✓ We use a lot of in positive sentences with plurals and uncountables. (A lot of ifadesini olumlu cümlelerde çoğullar ve sayılamayan isimlerle kullanırız.)
many	 There aren't many apples. many + plural noun	many: çok	✓ We use many in negative sentences and questions with plurals. (Many ifadesini olumsuz cümlelerde ve sorularda çoğul isimlerle kullanırız.)
much	 There isn't much milk. much + uncountable noun	much: çok	✓ We use much in negative sentences and questions with uncountables. (Much'ı olumsuz cümlelerde ve sorularda sayılamayan isimlerle kullanırız.)

• not many = a few

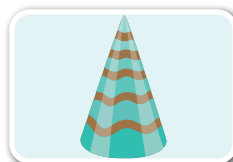

Refusing and Apologizing (Reddetme ve Özür Dileme)

- I'm afraid, I can't.
- I'd love to, but I can't make it.
- I'm sorry, but I'm busy then.
- I'd love to, but ...
- Sorry, but I can't.
- I'm sorry, but ...
- Sorry, but it's not a good idea.
- ✓ We use the expressions above to refuse and apologize. (Reddetmek ve özür bildirmek için yukarıdaki ifadeleri kullanırız.)

Requests (Rica cümleleri)

- Can you order the cake?
- Would you buy some eggs?
- Could you help me?
- ✓ We use the expressions above to make requests. (Ricada bulunurken yukarıda verilen ifadeleri kullanırız.)

Responding to Requests (Ricaya Karşılık Verme)

- Yes, of course.
- Sure.
- Certainly.
- I'd love to, but ...
- I'm sorry, but ...
