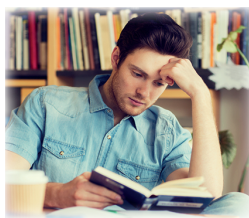

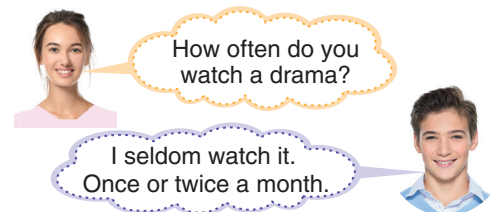

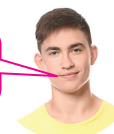
### Note

We can use a noun after **prefer**. If there is a verb, we add **-ing** to the verb. (**Prefer** fiilinden sonra bir isim kullanabiliriz. Eğer fiil var ise, fiile **-ing** takısı ekleriz.)

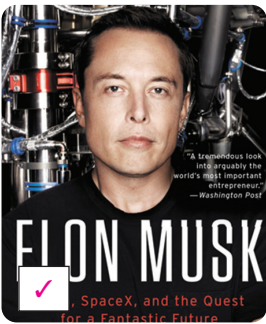
